## TESTIMONY

Being born into a Christian family, I had the opportunity and privilege to be exposed to who God is. When I was five, I said the sinner's prayer at home and committed myself to become a Christian. However, I did not fully understand what the sinner's prayer was about. As I grew older, I strayed further from God.

As a teenager, I continued to attend church regularly. However it felt more like a routine rather than something I wanted to do. I started to prioritise my own personal wants, friends and studies over attending bible class. I often left right after service just to complete my assignments or meet my project groups.

I decided that I should take a step further to publicly declare my faith in Christ.

Taking this step is just the beginning, and it is my prayer that God will continue to guide me through this path.

## TESTIMONY

I have grown up in Grace BP Church, spending my last 21 years in this church, not only attending weekly worship service, but also participating in many other church events; VBS, church camp, catechism classes etc, among many other activities. Being born into a Christian family meant that Sundays were always reserved for church, and the Christian faith was something that was a given in my life, but how far was I from the truth! And I think this is a problem that many 2nd generation Christians face, where we take for granted our faith and unlike our 1st generation Christian parents, don't see the transformative effect the faith has on their lives.

As I grew up, I began to question my faith, question the conviction I had, and at times wondered if the Christian faith I took so routinely, was even real to me at all. This was also coupled with the growing temptations of earthly desires, which appeared ever more appealing as I continued to mature.
